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Dear University of Arkansas Member,

In an effort to provide appropriate, affordable health care options while managing drug costs, the University of Arkansas prescription drug plan will move Rayos to being a non-covered drug effective September 1, 2018. As a result, you will see your cost share increase. We suggest you speak with your physician about lower-cost alternatives and the therapy most appropriate for your care. Some alternatives include generic, low cost prednisone tablets. Another alternative is brand name Deltasone (also prednisone) tablets for which there will be a brand name drug penalty since an equivalent generic is available for use.

The above change to your prescription drug plan is directed by the University of Arkansas Pharmacy Advisory Committee, who strive to maintain affordable and appropriate healthcare benefits
